“To increase the awareness of our relationship with the environment” is the mission of Kadoorie Farm & Botanic Garden. Kadoorie Farm and Botanic Garden (KFBG) are located in Hong Kong’s central New Territories. Its deep-set valley houses streams, woodland and terraces together with conservation and education facilities.

The Farm was established in the 1950s to bring agricultural aid to poor farmers. Today, reflecting the changing times, KFBG plays an active role in promoting the conservation and biodiversity as well as sustainable agriculture and creative nature education in Hong Kong and South China.

The intensive green roof with lawn vegetation was installed in 2002 on top of the admission and gift shop.
